


ABOUT THE PROGRAM

The Anderson Resident Artist Program was created in loving memory of Jacquelyn "Jackie" Anderson, a devoted photographer, creative force, and quiet champion of the arts who passed away from cancer in 2021. To honor her legacy, her husband, Jim Anderson, established a living tribute: The Jacquelyn, a private social club dedicated to wellness, creativity, and connection.

In the same spirit, the Anderson Resident Artist Program offers artists a transformational opportunity to focus exclusively on their craft, without the burden of earning a living while creating. This residency invites artists to engage with a deeply personal and inspiring source: a curated book of 300 original photographs by Jackie, selected by her husband to reflect their shared love of travel, nature, and the beautiful details found in everyday life.

THE JACQUELYN

The concept of The Jacquelyn was born from art and plays a pivotal role in creating an environment that facilitates connection, growth, and inspiration. Art serves as the universal language that transcends boundaries and brings people together, fostering meaningful dialogue and shared experiences within our community. Through creative expression, we witness the transformation of individual perspectives into collective understanding, as artists challenge us to see the world through new lenses and question our assumptions. The presence of working artists in our space creates a dynamic energy that ripples through every interaction, inspiring residents and visitors alike to approach their work and relationships with greater creativity and intentionality. Art doesn't simply decorate our walls—it actively shapes our culture, encouraging risk-taking, vulnerability, and authentic self-expression that ultimately drives purposeful action and deeper human connection.



WHAT THE RESIDENCY INCLUDES

- Four Artists Awarded Annually One per quarter
- Stipend to Offset Living Expenses & Art Supplies (not to exceed \$7,000 per month)
- Exclusive Access to Jacquelyn Anderson's Photography Book as creative source material 300 images
- Three Months of Dedicated Creative Time (residency is virtual unless the artist chooses to visit Sacramento)
- End-of-Residency Art Show hosted at The Jacquelyn in Sacramento, CA



PROMOTION

The Jacquelyn team will oversee promotion of the end-of-residency art show, including guest list management. Artists are encouraged to invite family and friends to attend.

- Each resident will also be featured in an exclusive story in The Jax Exchange and an episode of The Jax Social Exchange podcast.
- Artists are responsible for transporting or mailing their artwork. All proceeds from art sales go directly to the artist.

We invite artists 18 years or older, from anywhere in the United States or abroad, working in any medium, who are:

- Artists requiring a transformational opportunity in order to create a body of work.
- Able to commit to developing a **new body of work** over three months.
- Eager to collaborate creatively with Jackie's photography as a point of inspiration.
- Excited to share their work at a culminating show.

ELIGIBLE ART FORMS

We welcome proposals from artists working in any form of visual or interdisciplinary art, including:

- Photography
- Painting
- Drawing
- Sculpture
- Mixed Media
- Textile / Fiber Arts
- Digital Art
- Collage

- Film / Video / New Media
- Performance Art
- Spoken Word / Literary Arts
- Sound Art / Composition
- Ceramics
- Printmaking

If you have a unique or hybrid art form not listed, we encourage you to apply.



PROPOSAL REQUIREMENTS

To be considered, applicants must submit the following materials in a single PDF or folder (via email or file link):

1. Letter of Intent (max 1 page)

 Describe your artistic vision, how you would use this residency, and why this opportunity is meaningful to you

2. Proof of Concept

 Share a brief creative proposal outlining how you plan to draw inspiration from Jackie's photographic collection

3. Scope of Work

Timeline and structure for your project over the 3-month residency

4. Project Budget

• Include financial estimates for materials, supplies, and a breakdown of living expenses

5. Artist Resume / Bio

Highlight relevant artistic experience and/or exhibitions

6. Portfolio

• 5-10 images (or video/writing samples) of past work, with descriptions and dates

7. References (Optional)

Letters or contact information for people who can speak to your work

SELECTION PROCESS

Artists will be selected by The Anderson Family along with a small advisory team of creative professionals. The emphasis will be on artistic clarity, originality, alignment with Jackie's legacy, and potential for impact.

Finalists may be contacted for a virtual interview.

IMPORTANT NOTES

- Residency is remote; you do not need to reside in Sacramento.
- All applicants must be 18 years or older.
- All proceeds from the culminating show will go directly to the artist.
- You may apply more than once annually, but only one residency will be awarded per artist.
