Aman Tokyo

Aman Tokyo, Aman's first urban property, is a tranquil sanctuary set high above the capital's thriving Otemachi district, offering unrivalled views of the Imperial Palace Gardens, surrounding city landmarks and skyline of mountains including Mr Fuji. The hotel is the embodiment of its location, fantastically dynamic in design, resolutely in touch with its traditional Japanese sensibility.

The harmony of the architecture and design, combined with elements of the local milieu are a classic hallmark of any Aman, and this is no exception. The sixth Aman property to be designed by Kerry Hill Architects, Aman Tokyo cleverly reveals itself through a series of unique elements, perfectly blending a mix of traditional Japanese design with contemporary flair. Authentic materials such as wood, washi paper and stone are fused with modern technology and a variety of fabrics and textures to create a subtle interplay of shadow and light.

The centrepiece of Aman Tokyo's lobby and soaring nearly 30 metres high, is a majestic architectural feature resembling the interior of a Japanese paper lantern. The feature measures 40 metres long by 11 metres wide. Created with layers of textured washi paper and stretched to fit a shoji frame, the lantern rises six floors through the centre of the building. During the day, it allows diffused sunlight to illuminate the lobby, while in the evenings the ambience evolves via a series of orchestrated lighting scenes.

Beneath the lantern is the hotel's inner garden. Celebrating the creative and cultural tradition of Japan is the prominent Ikebana, a disciplined art form in which materials such as living branches, leaves and blossoms are carefully arranged to represent a closeness with nature. This sits atop a calming water feature and is complemented by two traditional Japanese rock gardens. Designed to reflect a feeling of Zen, the rock gardens feature boulders from northern Japan, are minimal in design, and intended to calm the mind, drawing it away from everyday concerns towards a place of respite. The inner garden is surrounded by an Engawa, a Japanese term for a wooden space between the garden and living areas in traditional homes.

Arva

A window to the city below, Arva offers panoramic views through large floor-to-ceiling windows. A breathtaking setting for any occasion, its location on the 33rd floor offers a dining experience inspired by the culinary culture of Italy. For weddings and events, Chef Masakazu Hiraki can create bespoke menus with bold flavours and seasonal ingredients. Arva's exceptional space can host up to 70 guests when seated.

Private Dining Room

Located on the upper floors of Arva, Aman Tokyo's Private Dining space offers spectacular views of the city's west side through floor-to-ceiling windows. A host of events can be curated in this space, ranging from private dinners and parties with bespoke menus to wine tastings and seminars arranged by Aman Tokyo's team. Seating up to eight guests, the space can be transformed, with decorations and floral arrangements arranged by the hotel's event planners, available upon request.

Musashi by Aman

In a tranquil space centred around a wooden counter, intimate occasions can be enjoyed over some of the city's finest sushi. For special occasions, exclusive use of the space allows up to 14 guests to watch Master Chef Musashi as he prepares an exquisite selection of sushi and sashimi based on the finest and freshest ingredients available that day. Perfect for private parties, the restaurant invites guests to experience the authentic Japanese omakase dining tradition.

The Cafe by Aman

Adjacent to the beautiful natural forest on the ground floor of Otemachi Tower, The Cafe by Aman serves relaxed French cuisine in a refined yet welcoming environment. For more formal occasions, the space can be used to seat up to 20 people with multi-course menus designed to suit the occasion, while for drinks receptions and more informal gatherings, the space can accommodate approximately 30 guests.

Boardroom

With lofty ceilings, floor-to-ceiling windows and unique contemporary art, Aman Tokyo's boardroom has a uniquely uplifting atmosphere. Accommodating up to 16 guests when seated, it is ideal for meetings and events offering an impressive and professional space to entertain in the heart of the city, with the hotel's dedicated team on hand to cater to every need.

Meeting Room

Accommodating up to six guests when seated, Aman Tokyo's meeting room is flooded with light, ideal for those seeking an inspiring environment for their next important business gathering. Intimate yet spacious, guests will enjoy views of Tokyo's cityscape and distant mountains during the day, and beautiful night views at dusk and at night – encouraging creativity and productivity, no matter what the occasion.

Facility Details

Aman Tokyo (Hotel Reservations)

Located in the capital's prestigious financial district adjacent to the 3,600-square-metre Otemachi Forest, Aman Tokyo presents 84 contemporary suites with a traditional Japanese aesthetic. Occupying the top six floors of the Otemachi Tower, the hotel offers scenic views of the Imperial Palace Gardens and Mount Fuji on the horizon, as well as easy access to all points of interest in the city, including the renowned Ginza shopping district. A peaceful inner garden, serene Aman Spa, swimming pool and several fine-dining venues complete the elevated sanctuary.

Aman Suite

At 157 square metres (1,689 square feet) in size, Aman Suites are the hotel's largest offering unparalleled urban living. Positioned on the building's northwest corner, they offer exceptional panoramas of the Japanese capital, including the skyscrapers of Shinjuku, the Imperial Palace gardens and on clearer days, Mount Fuji on the horizon. The suites feature large bedrooms with king-sized beds and a separate living spaces, additional powder rooms and dining tables for up to six guests, ideal for entertaining. Meanwhile, a desk and workspace can be configured as an extension to the room or concealed for privacy via a sliding pocket door. Through elegant shoji screens, a large bathroom with stone furo tub also enjoys remarkable views, alongside separate vanities.

Panorama Suite

139 square metres (1,497 square feet) in size, Panorama Suites are ideal for guests seeking exceptional views and an abundance of space. Their location on the Otemachi Tower's corners offers spectacular dual aspect vistas through floor-to-ceiling windows, which frame the Tokyo Tower and other city icons. Features include a separate bedroom, living and dining area seating four, alongside a large bathroom with stone furo tub and separate vanities accessed through elegant shoji sliding doors. A separate powder room, concealable workspace and lofty entranceway makes the Panorama Suite suitable for both business and leisure travellers alike.

Grand Suite

Offering 141 square metres (1,517 square feet) of space, Grand Suites are among Aman Tokyo's largest. Well suited to families or entertaining, they offer spectacular city views and feature an expansive separate living room, powder room and dining area with space for four guests. The bedroom can be configured with a choice of king or twin beds and the main bathroom, accessed via traditional shoji sliding screens, features a double vanity and stone furo tub for traditional bathing overlooking the city skyline. A spacious desk and workspace can be configured as an extension to the room or concealed for privacy via a sliding pocket door while the airy entrance foyer ensures suitability for business and leisure travellers alike.

City Suite

Situated in the northeast corner of the Otemachi Tower, Aman Tokyo's City Suites offer 121 square metres (1,302 square feet) of living space benefitting from dual aspect views which fill the space with light. While a separate bedroom with king-bed provides a restful place to sleep, the lofty separate living space features a dining room, lounge area and workspace which can be configured as a completely private space via a discreet sliding screen. Through shoji doors, a large bathroom features from a furo soaking tub for enjoying the ritual of traditional Japanese bathing, while double vanities and a separate powder room showcase a further generosity of space.

Garden View Suite

At 71 square metres (764 square feet), Garden View Suites are spacious city sanctuaries, filled with light which floods the room through west-facing floor-to-ceiling windows. From both the king-sized bed and bathroom, unrivalled panoramas of the Imperial Palace and Mount Fuji serve as a focal point, while a sunken living area and traditional furo soaking tub provide further space from which to relax and enjoy the view.

Deluxe Suite

Through floor-to-ceiling windows, Aman Tokyo's west-facing Deluxe Suites offer interrupted views of the Imperial Palace Gardens, the skyscrapers of Shinjuku and iconic Mount Fuji on the horizon. Spanning a generous 71 square metres (764 square feet), the bedroom features a choice of king-size or twin beds, with a spacious lounge area at its foot – the perfect location for watching the city's famous sunset. Through shoji sliding doors, the large bathroom invites traditional Japanese bathing in its furo soaking tub, while double vanities ensure ample space for two guests.

Tokyo Suite

City Suites span 77 square metres (829 square feet). With a large entrance and bathroom, they are the perfect retreat after a day exploring the city. Positioned in the east, the views are stunning at all hours. Reservations Inquiries: apo@aman.com
