Digital Platform Terms of Use

Effective Date: March 17, 2026

These Terms of Use ("Terms") govern your access to and use of the **Cattlemen's Club website, membership portal, and mobile application**, including reservations, event ticket purchases, and other services offered through the platform.

By creating an account, applying for membership, or using any Cattlemen's Club digital platform, you agree to these Terms.

1. About Cattlemen's Club

Cattlemen's Club is a private membership experience operated by **FWCS Restaurant, LLC**, located at:

The club provides members with access to dining reservations, ticketed events, exclusive experiences, and other membership benefits.

2. Membership Eligibility

Access to the Cattlemen's Club platform is limited to:

- Approved members of the club
- Guests invited by members
- Individuals authorized by the club

Membership approval is granted at the sole discretion of the club.

The club reserves the right to deny or revoke membership privileges at any time for violation of club policies.

3. Member Accounts

Members may be required to create an account through the Cattlemen's Club website or mobile app.

Members are responsible for:

- Maintaining the confidentiality of login credentials
- Ensuring their account information remains accurate
- All activity conducted under their account

If you believe your account has been compromised, you must notify the club immediately.

4. Reservations

Members may use the platform to make reservations at club dining venues.

Reservations are subject to availability.

The club reserves the right to:

- Modify reservation policies
- Cancel reservations when necessary
- Charge cancellation or no-show fees where applicable

Members are responsible for any charges incurred through reservations made under their account.

5. Event Tickets

Members may purchase tickets to club events through the platform.

Event policies may include:

- Limited ticket availability
- Member-only access
- Guest limits

Unless otherwise stated:

- Event tickets are **non-refundable**
- Tickets may not be resold without club approval

The club reserves the right to modify or cancel events.

6. Payments

Membership dues, event tickets, reservations, and other purchases may be processed through secure third-party payment providers integrated into the platform.

By submitting payment information through the Cattlemen's Club website, mobile application, or membership portal, you authorize the club and its payment processors to charge applicable fees associated with your membership, reservations, event tickets, guest purchases, and other services.

Members are responsible for all charges incurred through their account, including charges made by authorized guests.

The club reserves the right to update pricing, dues, or service fees with reasonable notice.

7. Acceptable Use of the Platform

Members agree not to:

- Use the platform for unlawful purposes

- Interfere with platform security or operations
- Attempt unauthorized access to other member accounts
- Distribute harmful software or malicious code
- Misuse club content or intellectual property

Violation of these terms may result in suspension or termination of access.

8. Member Conduct

Cattlemen's Club is intended to provide a welcoming and respectful environment.

Members and guests are expected to conduct themselves in a manner consistent with the club's standards.

The club reserves the right to suspend or terminate membership privileges for behavior that is:

- disruptive
- abusive
- unlawful
- inconsistent with club policies

9. Guest Policy

Members may invite guests to the club subject to the following guidelines.

Guest Limit

Members may bring **up to three (3) guests per visit unless otherwise approved by the club.**

Member Presence Required

Guests must be accompanied by the sponsoring member at all times while on club premises.

Guests **may not access the club without the member present** and must **arrive with and depart with the member.**

Member Responsibility

The sponsoring member is responsible for the conduct of their guests while on the premises and for any charges incurred by their guests, including dining, event tickets, or other purchases.

Guest Conduct

Guests are expected to comply with all club policies and standards of conduct. The club reserves the right to refuse entry or service to any guest whose behavior is disruptive, inappropriate, or inconsistent with the club's standards.

Guest Access

Guest access may be restricted during certain member-only events or at the discretion of the club.

10. Photography, Recording & Member Privacy Policy

To preserve the privacy of members and maintain the intimate and exclusive atmosphere of the club, **photography, video recording, live streaming, video calls (including FaceTime), or other forms of recording inside the club are not permitted unless approved in advance by the club.**

Members and guests may not:

- Photograph or record inside club spaces
- Live stream or broadcast from the club
- Use video calls within club areas
- Post or publish images or videos of the club interior, members, or private events on social media or other public platforms

Members are responsible for ensuring their guests comply with this policy.

Club staff may respectfully remind members or guests of this policy and request that photography, recording, or video calls cease. In certain situations, the club may require the deletion of unauthorized images or recordings.

Failure to comply with this policy may result in suspension or termination of membership privileges.

11. Intellectual Property & Member-Only Content

All content available through the Cattlemen's Club platform—including logos, images, event descriptions, digital materials, and member communications—is the property of the club or its licensors.

Members may not copy, distribute, reproduce, publicly share, photograph, record, screenshot, or commercially exploit this content without written permission from the club.

Certain materials available through the platform may be designated as **member-only content**, including event details, club communications, and other information intended exclusively for Cattlemen's Club members. Members agree not to share, distribute, or publish such content publicly without the prior consent of the club.

12. Third-Party Platforms

Certain services may be provided through third-party platforms, including membership management software and payment processors.

The club is not responsible for the availability or performance of third-party services.

13. Disclaimer

The platform and all services are provided **“as is” and “as available.”**

The club makes no guarantees regarding:

- uninterrupted access
- system availability

- accuracy of platform content

14. Limitation of Liability

To the maximum extent permitted by law, Cattlemen's Club and its affiliates shall not be liable for any indirect, incidental, or consequential damages arising from the use of the platform or services.

15. Termination

The club may suspend or terminate access to the platform for:

- violation of these Terms
- misuse of club services
- behavior inconsistent with club policies

Members may also cancel their accounts at any time, subject to membership agreements and billing terms.

16. Governing Law

These Terms are governed by the laws of the **State of Texas**, without regard to conflict of law principles.

Any disputes arising under these Terms shall be resolved in the courts located in **Tarrant County, Texas**.

17. Changes to These Terms

Cattlemen's Club may update these Terms periodically.

When changes are made, the **Effective Date** will be updated. Continued use of the platform constitutes acceptance of the revised Terms.
