CLUB RULES

Club Hue is a private, members-only Club located in Koreatown, California. All members and their guests are expected to uphold the Club's standards of conduct and comply with these House Rules. These guidelines are intended to foster a respectful, inclusive, and enjoyable environment for all participants. Club Hue reserves the right, at its sole discretion, to ask any member or guest to leave the premises, temporarily or permanently, if their behavior violates these standards or otherwise disrupts the orderly operation of the Club. Continued or serious violations may result in suspension or termination of membership, subject to the procedures set forth in the membership agreement and these rules.

IN BRIEF

CLUB RULES IN BRIEF

At HUE, our standards are rooted in intention, elegance, and mutual respect. To ensure every experience remains exceptional, members and their guests are kindly asked to observe the following:

DRESS WITH CARE

Members and guests are expected to dress smart casual and appropriate to the hour. Flip-flops, tank tops, sleeveless shirts, and beachwear are not permitted.

MOBILE USAGE & PHOTOGRAPHY

The use of cameras, video equipment, recording devices, or live streaming technology is strictly prohibited inside the Club. Members are responsible for ensuring their guests comply with this policy. HUE reserves the right to confiscate any device used for unauthorized recording, delete any captured media, and to take disciplinary action, including termination of membership without refund, against any member or guest who violates this rule.

MEMBER & GUEST PRIVACY

Members and guests are expected to respect the privacy of others at all times. Approaching or disturbing fellow members without invitation is strictly prohibited at Club HUE.

GUESTS ARE YOUR RESPONSIBILITY

Members must accompany their guests at all times and ensure they follow all club rules and etiquette. Guests must depart the club with the member who invited them; no guest may remain once their member has left.

CHILDREN & PETS

Club Hue is an adults-only environment. Individuals under the age of 21, including children, are not permitted on the premises at any time. Animals are not permitted on Club Hue premises, with the exception of service animals as defined by applicable law. Emotional support animals and pets are not permitted.

RECIPROCAL CLUBS

When visiting our partner clubs, members are expected to uphold HUE's standards and respect the policies of the host venue.

PROPERTY & LIABILITY

Belongings are brought at your own risk. HUE is not responsible for lost, stolen, or damaged items within the club, or at affiliated clubs.

COMMUNITY

- Act with respect and kindness at all times.
- Sexual conduct, whether physical, verbal, or in any form, is strictly prohibited.
- Members and guests must follow club decorum and show respect to others.
- Aggressive or harassing behavior is not allowed. This includes sexually explicit comments toward members, guests, or staff.
- Harassment should be reported to management, and if substantiated, membership may be subject to termination.

- Monday -Thursday: 11am to 12am
- Friday & Saturday: 11am to 2am
- Saturday & Sunday Brunch: 10am to 2pm

CLUB RULES

1. The Club

Each member enters into a membership agreement with Club Hue (referred to as “HUE” or the “Club” throughout these rules). HUE reserves the right to establish and charge an initiation fee, annual membership dues, and, where applicable, additional entry fees for access to the Club or specific events. HUE retains the sole discretion to amend, waive, or adjust any such fees at any time, subject to applicable notice requirements set forth in the membership agreement or these rules.

2. Your Membership Application

By submitting a membership application through the Club Hue website, you agree to comply with all Club rules and policies. The Membership Committee reviews applications throughout the year and admits new members based on availability. All membership decisions are made at the sole discretion of the Membership Committee and Membership Team, and such decisions are final. Applicants may withdraw their application at any time by contacting **membership@Clubhue.com**. If approved, you will receive a written confirmation of acceptance, and your membership will become effective upon receipt of any required initiation fees and dues as specified in your membership agreement.

3. Under 30 Membership

Members accepted into the Under 30 membership category will retain the discounted membership rate through the end of the membership year in which they reach the age of 30. Upon renewal for the following membership year, the member will automatically transition to the standard membership rate then in effect.

4. Proposing New Members

Members are encouraged to propose qualified individuals for membership at Club Hue. Prospective applicants must submit a completed application form, which is available on the Club Hue website. All applications are subject to the standard membership review and approval process at HUE’s sole discretion. Membership fees for proposed or new members are determined based on the date of approval, not the date of application submission, and subject to HUE’s discretion.

5. Membership Renewal

Membership requires a one-year commitment, with renewals occurring annually. While renewal is automatic, continued membership remains at the discretion of the membership team. The Club reserves the right to approve or decline renewals, and all decisions are final and not subject to appeal.

6. Membership Database

Membership at Club Hue requires a one-year commitment and is subject to annual renewal. Memberships will automatically renew each year unless otherwise terminated in accordance with the membership agreement. Continued membership remains at the sole discretion of the Membership Team, which reserves the right to approve or decline any renewal. All renewal decisions are final and not subject to appeal.

7. Membership Payment and Initiation Dues

Upon membership approval or renewal, initiation fees and membership fees are due immediately. Initiation fees are non-refundable and required upon acceptance, while annual dues will be charged within 30 days of approval. However, during the Club’s construction phase, only the initiation fee will be collected promptly, with annual dues deferred until the Club officially opens.

By providing payment information, you authorize HUE to charge fees in accordance with your membership agreement and any Club payment terms. HUE reserves the right to modify membership fees, billing dates, and payment frequencies at its sole discretion, provided advance notice is given.

Annual dues must be paid within thirty (30) days of the due date to maintain active membership status. Memberships are personal and non-transferable.

ACH payments are preferred; credit card payments are accepted and will incur a 3.5% processing fee. Applicable taxes will be charged in accordance with local regulations and will be added to the stated prices. All prices, including initiation fees and membership dues, are exclusive of applicable taxes and fees, which will be itemized on member statements.

8. Resignation of Your Membership

If you choose to resign your membership prior to the end of your membership term, you remain responsible for payment of the full annual dues for that membership year. Any refund or waiver of outstanding dues is at the sole discretion of HUE and must be confirmed in writing.

9. Membership Termination

If you choose to resign your membership, or your membership is revoked or terminated prior to the end of your membership year, you remain responsible for payment of the full annual dues for that membership year. Any refund or waiver of outstanding dues is at the sole discretion of HUE and must be confirmed in writing. Upon termination of your membership by HUE, you will no longer have access to the Club or be permitted to enter as a guest. All decisions regarding membership termination are at the sole discretion of HUE and are final.

10. Membership Cards; House Cards

Members are required to scan their digital membership card upon entry and present it when opening a tab within the Club. Lending or allowing a non-member to use your membership card is strictly prohibited and may result in membership termination, while the unauthorized guest will be denied entry.

The Club offers a "House Card" feature accessible through its mobile application. This feature allows members to charge purchases, including meals, beverages, and activities, directly to their member account. By using the House Card or choosing bill-less payment, you authorize the Club to process charges to your account without requiring your physical or electronic signature at the time of purchase. All transactions will be processed through Toast or any other payment platform, and detailed statements of charges will be available in your member account.

11. Your Personal Information

Your personal information will be collected, used, and stored in accordance with HUE's Privacy Policy, available at [\[SEE PRIVACY POLICY HERE\]](#). Your information will be used solely for purposes related to your membership and Club operations, subject to applicable privacy laws.

12. Guest Allowance

Members may bring one guest as a walk-in to the Club at any time, subject to availability. Additional guests must be included through a reservation made via the app, with advance booking required. Guest allowances vary by Club space, and any guests beyond the permitted limit require approval from the Membership Team. Larger dining arrangements must be coordinated through Club Reception.

To ensure that all members can fully enjoy the Club, HUE reserves the right to manage guest access during peak hours or high-traffic periods. In the event the Club reaches capacity, members hosting guests may be politely asked to adjust their party size to accommodate incoming members. This will always be handled with discretion and respect, and special circumstances should be communicated with the Club staff in advance. Our goal is to maintain a harmonious balance between hospitality and ensuring a welcoming space for all members.

13. Guest Conduct & Member's Responsibility

Guests are only permitted entry to the Club when accompanied by the inviting member and must remain with them throughout their visit. Members may not leave their guests unattended or allow them to stay in the Club after they depart. Members are fully responsible for the conduct of their guests and must ensure that guests comply with all Club rules and policies. Any violation of these rules by a guest may result in disciplinary action against the sponsoring member, including suspension or termination of membership.

14. Dress Code

Please ensure that you as a member and your guests represent yourselves in a way that is conducive to the elevated and refined environment of the Club. We foster a relaxed yet refined atmosphere, and encourage our guests to opt for smart casual attire. Management reserves the right to refuse entry to anyone deemed unsuitably dressed. Members and guests are expected to dress smart casual and appropriate to the hour. Flip-flops, tank tops, sleeveless shirts, beachwear, and other overly casual attire are not permitted. Management reserves the right, at its sole discretion, to deny entry to any member or guest whose attire is deemed inappropriate.

15. Privacy for Members/Guests

Members and their guests must respect the privacy and personal space of others at all times. Unsolicited interactions with individuals you do not personally know are discouraged and any conduct that disrupts another member's experience is strictly prohibited. Behavior that infringes upon the comfort or privacy of other members or guests may result in disciplinary action, including suspension or termination of membership.

16. Children

Club Hue is an adults-only environment. Individuals under the age of 21, including children, are not permitted on the premises at any time.

17. Mobile Phones/Computers

To maintain the Club's tranquil ambiance, phone calls are not permitted in common areas, and devices should remain on silent mode. Texting is allowed, and calls may only be made in designated areas. Members are responsible for ensuring that their guests respect this policy.

The use of laptop and other computers is strictly prohibited at all times on the Club premises.

18. Cameras/Recording devices

The use of cameras, video equipment, recording devices, or live streaming technology is strictly prohibited inside the Club. Members are responsible for ensuring their guests comply with this policy. HUE reserves the right to confiscate any device used for unauthorized recording, delete any captured media, and to take disciplinary action, including termination of membership without refund, against any member or guest who violates this rule.

19. Audio/Video sound

All audio content, including movies, videos, music, presentations, and internet calls, must be listened to exclusively through headphones and should not be audible to others. Internet calls are not permitted.

20. Bills

All bills must be paid in full before leaving the Club, as credit facilities are not available. Members are responsible for any charges incurred by their guests, and failure to settle outstanding balances may result in membership suspension. HUE operates as a cashless venue, and members are required to maintain a valid payment method on file.

For members who choose bill-less payment, a gratuity of 20% will be automatically added to all transactions at the Club to support HUE staff. Members are welcome to provide additional gratuity at their discretion.

21. Outside Food and Beverages

Except as expressly provided herein, no outside food or beverages are allowed in the Club, unless medically necessary with prior approval from Club management.

For private events, members or guests may bring their own beverages on special occasions. A corkage fee of \$50 per 750ml bottle will apply. The corkage fee is subject to change without notice. For private events, the first bottle is complimentary; corkage fees will apply to each additional bottle.

On special occasions, members may bring in a cake or dessert. A dessert service fee may apply, such as a cake-cutting fee of \$5 per person. Fees are subject to change without notice.

22. Illegal drugs/Substances/Items

The possession, use, sale, distribution, or attempted exchange of illegal drugs or substances by any member or guest is strictly prohibited at HUE. Additionally, no member or guest may solicit illegal substances from HUE staff. Any violation of this policy will result in immediate removal from the Club, termination of membership, and, if necessary, further action.

Furthermore, members and guests are forbidden from possessing, selling, or using any illegal objects on Club premises or in its immediate surroundings. If such items are discovered, the individual(s) involved will be removed from the Club, their membership revoked, and, where applicable, authorities may be notified.

23. Security Personnel

The Club recognizes that some members and guests may require personal security personnel. To preserve the comfort, safety, and discretion of all members, the following policies apply:

- Members or guests accompanied by security personnel must ensure that their security teams conduct themselves with professionalism and discretion at all times.
- The presence of security personnel should not interfere with the experience of other members, staff, or guests.
- Security personnel may not openly display weapons or conduct any activity that draws undue attention within Club premises.
- Firearms and other weapons are strictly prohibited on the Club premises, except as expressly permitted by applicable law and with the prior written consent of the Club management.
- Members are required to notify the Club management in advance if they will be accompanied by armed security, so that appropriate discretion and coordination can be maintained.
- The Club reserves the right to deny entry or request the removal of any individual whose presence, conduct, or security arrangements are deemed inconsistent with the Club's environment and member experience.

24. Confidentiality

Members are expected to uphold strict confidentiality regarding fellow members and guests. Disclosing or identifying individuals present at HUE—whether through press, social media, personal blogs or any other platform—is strictly prohibited. Likewise, members and their guests must refrain from sharing details about private events or member-exclusive gatherings held within the Club.

HUE's management and staff are equally committed to discretion, maintaining the highest confidentiality standards to protect all personal information and Club activities.

25. Event Booking and Club Maintenance

At times, all or certain areas of HUE may be temporarily closed to members and guests for private events, maintenance, repairs, or renovations. When the Club is reserved for a private booking, we ask that members respect the privacy of these events and refrain from sharing any details with third parties through any medium. HUE reserves the right not to disclose information regarding the nature of private bookings.

In cases where maintenance, repairs, renovations or safety-related closures are necessary, or when certain facilities must be withdrawn due to safety concerns or operational needs, we will make reasonable effort to restore access as quickly as possible to minimize disruption to our members. We appreciate your understanding and cooperation in these instances.

26. Club Events

HUE may occasionally film, photograph, or record member events and activities within the Club for use in membership programs, promotions, advertising, public relations, and other business purposes, subject to the terms of HUE's Privacy Policy **[SEE PRIVACY POLICY HERE]**. By participating in these events, you acknowledge and consent to the use of your name, image, and limited personal details for such purposes. You further agree that any such materials created by or for HUE may be used, reproduced, displayed, and published in any medium without further notice or additional consent, and you waive any claim to compensation or rights of approval related to such use.

27. Accidents and Injuries

At HUE, we strive to create an environment where all members and guests can relax and enjoy the Club's activities and facilities in a safe and welcoming atmosphere. Members and their guests are expected to adhere to the House rules and follow any posted signs throughout the Club. We encourage everyone to exercise reasonable caution when moving through the Club, especially when participating in activities around our live stage, karaoke room, or other active areas.

Members and guests acknowledge and agree that they participate in all activities at their own risk. HUE disclaims any liability for personal injuries, accidents, or property damage sustained while on Club premises or while dancing, participating in Club activities or navigating these areas. By entering the premises, members and guests assume full responsibility for their personal safety and well-being.

28. Entering/Leaving the Club

We kindly ask all members and their guests to be mindful of our neighboring residents by keeping noise levels low when arriving at or departing from the Club, as well as when spending time in the surrounding area.

29. Animals

Animals are not permitted on Club Hue premises, with the exception of service animals as defined by applicable law. Emotional support animals and pets are not permitted.

30. CCTV Surveillance

For the safety and security of all members, guests, and staff, Club Hue uses closed-circuit television (CCTV) monitoring in certain areas of the premises. By entering the Club, members and guests consent to such monitoring. CCTV footage is used solely for security and operational purposes and is handled in accordance with HUE's Privacy Policy [[SEE PRIVACY POLICY HERE](#)].

31. Smoking Policy

All members and their guests are required to adhere to HUE's smoking policy as well as all applicable local, state, and federal no-smoking laws. Smoking, including the use of e-cigarettes and vaping devices, is strictly prohibited inside the Club.

Designated outdoor smoking areas may be provided, with locations subject to change at HUE's discretion. We kindly ask that members and their guests respect the comfort of others and refrain from smoking if requested by fellow members or staff.

32. Rights and Privileges of Membership

Membership at HUE grants individuals access to all rights, privileges, and benefits associated with the Club, and each member is expected to adhere to the Club's rules and policies at all times. Membership does not confer any ownership interest in the Club or its assets.

33. Disciplinary Procedure

Behavior by a member or guest that may harm the reputation, operations or integrity of HUE, as determined in the sole discretion of HUE, can result in suspension or termination of membership. This includes, but is not limited to, inappropriate, abusive, or violent behavior, as well as the unauthorized sharing of information regarding Club affairs, members, or their guests with the media. Individuals who have been expelled are prohibited from returning to HUE as a guest, and any refund of membership fees will be at HUE's sole discretion.

Members are also held responsible for any willful damage, removal, or destruction of property belonging to the Club, its members, or guests while on Club premises. Such actions may lead to expulsion, suspension, or permanent termination of membership.

By accepting membership at HUE, every member agrees to abide by the Club's rules, bylaws, and policies at all times. If a member's conduct, or that of their guest, is deemed, at HUE's sole discretion, to be contrary to the Club's values or interests, HUE reserves the right to immediately suspend, expel, or terminate membership without the obligation to provide further explanation.

34. Liability Disclaimer

All personal belongings brought into HUE, or any affiliated partner Clubs are the sole responsibility of the member or their guests and are left at their own risk. HUE, along with its officers, employees, agents, staff and representatives, is not liable for any loss, theft, damage, or injury to personal property, regardless of the cause. This exclusion of liability does not apply in cases of death or personal injury resulting from the proven negligence of HUE, its staff, or agents. Members are advised to familiarize themselves with the specific rules and liability policies of partner Clubs prior to their visit, as these may vary. This policy does not affect any legal rights members or guests may have under applicable local laws that cannot be legally waived or excluded.

35. Conduct While Visiting Partner Clubs

As a member of HUE, you are extended the privilege of accessing a curated network of distinguished private Clubs both domestically and internationally. When visiting these reciprocal Clubs, it is imperative to uphold the highest standards of conduct, reflecting the values and ethos of HUE. This includes adhering to the host Club's specific rules, dress codes, and etiquette, which may differ from those at HUE. We recommend reviewing the host Club's guidelines prior to your visit, often available on their official website, to ensure a seamless and respectful experience. Remember, your behavior not only represents you but also the HUE community at large; thus, demonstrating courtesy, discretion, and appreciation is essential in fostering and maintaining these esteemed relationships.

36. Amendments to the Club Rules

HUE reserves the right to update or modify the Club rules at any time. Any changes will be communicated through notifications on the HUE app, website and/or by email. Please note that the rules outlined in your membership materials may not always reflect the most current version. For the latest and most accurate Club rules, members should refer to the official version available on our website.

37. HUE Trademark Rights

Members and their guests are strictly prohibited from using HUE's name, logo, trademarks, service marks, colors, images, or any other distinctive identifiers (collectively referred to as the "HUE Marks") without obtaining prior written permission from HUE for each specific use.

By accepting membership, you acknowledge that the HUE Marks are the sole and exclusive property of HUE, including its parent company, affiliates, and subsidiaries. Members and guests may not create, reproduce, distribute, or authorize the use of the HUE Marks for any purpose, including but not limited to marketing, advertising, communications, or promotional materials (such as brochures, flyers, invitations, or emails), without HUE's explicit written consent.

38. Force Majeure

HUE shall not be liable for any failure or delay in performing its obligations under these rules or the membership agreement if such failure or delay results from events or circumstances beyond its reasonable control, including but not limited to natural disasters, pandemics, government restrictions, labor disputes, fire, flood, or other acts of God.

39. Governing Law and Venue

These Club Rules and any disputes arising under them shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the State of California, without regard to its conflict of law principles. Any legal action or proceeding arising out of or relating to membership or use of the Club must be brought exclusively in the state or federal courts located in Los Angeles County, California.

40. Dispute Resolution

At the sole discretion of HUE, any dispute, claim, or controversy arising out of or relating to membership, these Club Rules, or use of the Club may be submitted to confidential binding arbitration under the rules of the American Arbitration Association, with the arbitration to take place in Los Angeles County, California. The decision of the arbitrator shall be final and binding on all parties.

41. General Waiver of Liability

Members and guests acknowledge and agree that participation in Club activities, programs, and amenities, including but not limited to classes, private events, outdoor activities, and use of recreational areas, is voluntary and at their own risk. Members and guests agree to release and hold harmless HUE, its officers, employees, agents, and affiliates from any claims, liabilities, or damages arising out of or related to participation in any Club activities, except to the extent caused by HUE's proven gross negligence or willful misconduct.

42. Severability

If any provision of these Club Rules is found to be invalid, illegal, or unenforceable, the remaining provisions shall continue in full force and effect.

43. No Assignment

Membership rights and privileges are personal to the member and may not be transferred, assigned, or otherwise conveyed to any other person or entity without the prior written consent of HUE.

44. Member Code of Conduct

All members and guests are expected to act with integrity, respect, and courtesy toward fellow members, guests, and Club staff. Conduct that is abusive, harassing, discriminatory, or otherwise inconsistent with the values and interests of Club Hue may result in disciplinary action, including suspension or termination of membership.
