

Updated COVID-19 Policy

mHUB Members,

We are happy to report some changes in the mHUB COVID-19 protocol as the city moves into <u>Phase</u> <u>4 Tier 2</u> in the state's reopening plan. From this point forward, we will allow visitors back in the space, in common spaces only. While the visitor policy changes, the rest of our COVID restrictions remain in place including:

- Masks are required at all times in all areas of the building with the exception of private offices
- Please keep 6+ feet distance with everyone in the space
- Visitors are welcome in private offices or common areas (conference rooms, hall with tables, event space)
- Gatherings limited to **10 people**
- Building capacity at **50%**
- All members and visitors must check-in when in person and answer COVID questions
- Any member who has been in contact with someone diagnosed with COVID 19 should quarantine for 14 days after the last contact
- If member reports having any COVID-19 related symptoms, they should remain isolated at home for a minimum of 10 days after symptom onset AND until feverless and feeling well (without medication) for at least 72 hours OR confirmed to not have COVID-19 via 2 negative COVID-19 tests in a row, with testing done at least 24 hours apart

Our goal is to ensure you have access to the resources you need. However, if we experience any degree of COVID spread we will quickly shut down for a deep clean. We are doing everything in our power to avoid this disruption and are active in monitoring and contact tracing for any potential exposure.
